(2) Achievements and Reflection on Major Concerns

Priority Task 1: Enhance students' life skills through diversified learning experiences

Achievements

Our school open and provid diverse learning experiences for students to enhance their life skills through competitions in different disciplines and innovative curriculum in the Gifted and Talented Programs. Geography department encourage students to engage in different environmental competitions to enhance their awareness and knowledge in environmental education. In the “Blue-Green Partnership Programme Water Wise Student Ambassador Scheme”, 2 students were awarded “Gold Award”, 3 students were awarded “Silver Award” and 2 students were awarded “Bronze Award”. The school was awarded a bronze award. A student obtained a Merit award in the “Building the Islands of the Future Design Competition Study on the Artificial Islands in the Central Waters.

6 G8 to G11 students participated in a very prestigious annual competition “Hong Kong Young Writers Awards” which foster excellence in creativity. 2 students were awarded a Winner prize in the Bauhinia Club Non-Fiction and Bauhinia Club Poetry respectively. 2 students were awarded Honourable Mention in the Creative Writing Fiction and 2 students were shortlisted in the Creative Writing Fiction.

3 G11 and G12 students were awarded Merit Awards in the mediation essay competition 2022 organized by the Department of Justice, the Education Bureau and Asia Conflict Resolution Institute Limited. The competition aims to raise awareness on the use of mediation in daily life to solve conflicts through essay writing.

In November, 10 G11 students participated in an annual climate change Model United Nations forum “Good Cop Bad Cop” to give a presentation on climate change from their experience in Hong Kong and to debate under the role of UK delegates.

In December, two students from Green Committee joined the Blue Society Summit (2022) organized by the Chinese Manufacturers' Association of Hong Kong to discuss the major concerns of marine eco-systems with representatives from different countries such as Australia, Fiji, Mexico, South Africa, etc. Also, 33 students participated in the Tchoukball Geneva Indoors 2022 which was held in Geneva and the teams won “1st runner-up” in M12 group, “Champion” and “2nd runner-up” in M14 Boys, “1st runner-up” in M14 Girls and “1st runner-up” in M18. Moreover, our school's Economics students have achieved remarkable success in the International Economics Olympiad Winter Challenge 2023, winning a total of 19 medals including 2 gold medals, 7 silver medals and 10 bronze medals.

In April, 9 students joined the Greater Bay Area Youth Exchange Program in Guangzhou to visit universities and firms to learn the latest technological developments of the area, exchange with students in Guangzhou and went to cultural heritage sites.

Different project-based learning activities in different subjects were provided for students to develop their social skills, generic skills and self-directed learning. In the Consumer Culture Study Award (CCSA) co-organized by the Consumer Council and the Education Bureau since 1999, students needed to select a local consumption topic they were interested in and conduct in-depth studies and submitted reports on selected consumer behaviours, attitudes and values. A team of 5 G12 students was awarded “Second runner-up” in the competition. In a project study competition “將軍 O 的足跡” which promote the history and culture of Tseung Kwan O District through various activities, and promote the concepts of caring for others and protecting the community to young people, a team of 4 G11 students obtained a Merit award and creativity award.

International Exchange Programmes allow students to exchange knowledge and culture with global peers. This year, several online and physical international exchange activities were held. 12 G8 and G9 students participated in the online exchange programme co-organized by High School Affiliated to Beijing Institute of Technology (BIT) and our school in September to allow students to explore the local culture and experience the teaching style of the two regions. A variety of online lessons, including discussions, online competitions and video presentations were conducted to connect students with their peers in Beijing. Besides, a team of 3 students participated in the international student conference organized by Ritsumeikan High School in Japan to learn of worldwide food problems and solutions with global peers. In February, 10 students joined the GTC-KVIS exchange programme to go to KVIS, a leading science high school in Thailand. In July and August, a month-long Australian Immersion program was held for 80 selected G7 to G10 students to live with Australian host families, attend school with local buddies and explore different areas of wildlife and nature in addition to taking classes taught by Aussie teachers. This was a great chance for students to learn about the Australian culture while improving their English language skills. In the end of April, the GTC-MWIT- and -KVIS exchange programme was held. In a week-long visit, our students brought their Thai buddies to different excursion activities in addition to the normal classes in school which made a rewarding journey for Thai students.

The 2022 Gifted and Talented Programs (GTP) including Club & Interest (C&I), Talent Class (TC), Elective Day (ED) and Sports Friday form a crucial component of the curriculum, allowing students to pursue different disciplines, STEM and Third Languages, arts and sports with an integration of the leading and innovative learning elements into the contents. Nearly all the students were matched with their top choices in each program which allow them to engage in subjects that they truly passionate about.

The curriculum of Accelerated and Enrichment (AE) classes of all subjects including Chinese Language, English Language, Mathematics, Science, Music and Sports was refined to encourage the increase use of technology in learning. Authentic performance tasks such as project video, press release, drama show, podcast, Youtube video, performances, research projects and various competitions were commonly used as learning outcomes for student learning.

Reflection

This year, school open and provide diverse learning experience for students both nationally and internationally. These include different environmental competitions, creative writing competitions, mediation competition, United Nation climate change forum, Tchoukball Geneva Indoors and International Economic Olympiad which enhance students' knowledge and skills in the learning subjects. The competitions allow students to interface with global challenges, new sports and Olympiad events and earn awards to recognise their efforts. The performance of students were outstanding showing that the learning curriculum, supports from supervising teachers and student efforts achieved high standards. Students also performed well in project-based competitions in which the learning processes developed their generic skills such as communication, team works, collaboration, etc in addition to knowledge and skills. Furthermore, international exchange programmes were resumed both physically and online which provided opportunities for students to have exchange with global peers. With the Third Language courses in the GTP, students were able to communicate and learn from their global peers. Continuous supports will be provided for students to explore and unleash their potential in different areas. This year, a team of students joined the Greater Bay Area Youth Exchange Program in Guangzhou to visit universities and firms to learn the latest technological developments of the area, exchange with students in Guangzhou and went to cultural heritage sites. More visits to different cities of Greater Bay Area (GBA) will be arranged to build up connection between students in different GBA and to allow students to learn of recent development of the GBA.

Priority Task 2: Cultivate students’ positive values and develop good citizenship among students

Achievements

Our school organize different programmes and activities to enable students to have a better understanding about a sense of well-being and care for others.

To develop students to be a well-informed and responsible citizen, Green Committee in school organized several activities to promote the concept of green environment and sustainable development, including game booths and assembly presentation. There were over 200 students participated in the events. Green Committee also organized the Mooncake Box Recovery Programme to promote the concept of recycling.

To develop students strong sense of belonging and positive values and attitudes, several alumni and students activities were organized to foster the support and build networks between students and alumni. In the end of September, careers and university consultation night was organized for G12 students and parents. 19 alumni were invited to share their work experience and professional development after graduation with G12 students. In January 2023, an alumni New Year Gathering & Sports Competition for alumni students and teachers was held to build up friendship and allow alumni to reunite in the event.

To nurture our students with an affection for our country and Hong Kong and equipped with global perspective, an aspiring mind-set and positive thinking, activities to meet different policy makers were arranged. In January, 10 G10 and G11 students attend a programme to have a dialogue with Miss Alice Mak, the Secretary for Home and Youth Affairs. Besides, to deepen students’ understanding on macroeconomic issues such as government expenditure and the economic development of Hong Kong, all G10 and G11 Economics students had a dialogue with Financial Secretary Mr. Chan Mo Po at the HKFYG Building.

On the occasion of the 73rd National Day of the People’s Republic of China, our school invited Ka Wah Tong, a senior counsel and convenor of Path of Democracy to give his perspective on “One Country, Two Systems”. The talk gave students the opportunity to optimize their exposure to different topics in national education and strengthen their awareness of their national identity. In G7 Mentorship and G8 Leadership Training programmes, our school customized moral education curriculum to focus on students’ problem solving, presentation and communication skills. Students’ feedback were positive throughout the programmes.

To let students realize the importance of emotional health, the Moral Education Group held a series of teaching sharing to teach students how to be a responsible citizen and develop positive values. To foster harmonious campus atmosphere, a few teachers were dressed in various characters, gave out candies and took photo with students in a Halloween costume wearing day. Also, singing Contest was held in December in which both students and teachers demonstrate their talents on the stage.

Reflection

With the loosening of Covid preventive measure, more activities were held in school to foster harmonious atmosphere, cultivate students' positive value and good citizenship. G7 and G8 mentorship programmes were continued to instill positive values and promote student well-being through different activities. The programmes also allow students to exchanging ideas and sharing their life experiences with their class teachers and classmates. Different Government policy makers were invited to share the blueprint for youth development and recent country development in order to nurture students with an affection for our country and Hong Kong and equipped with global perspective, an aspiring mind-set and positive thinking. Students also had chance to participate community service in order to develop a good citizenship. More than 70 students participated in the beach cleanup activity organized by Zero Plastic League, a student-led environmental group in our school in May. More than 100 students participated in the "Bye Bye microbead" online challenge organized by Environmental Protection Department to learn of microplastic pollution.

Priority Task 3: Develop students' lifelong learning of STEM literacy to keep pace with fast changing technological development

Achievements

Our school open new STEM events and competitions for students in order to allow them to learn of new technological development and make contribution to the society. A new student-led environmental group "Zero Plastic League (ZPL)" was launched with the vision to use science and technology to address the plastic pollution problem. The team is consisted of 1 supervising teacher, 8 GT students and 2 students from Sing Yin Secondary School. This year, ZPL organized a variety of activities which received many positive responses from participants and partnership invitations. The activities including creation of a YouTube Channel to educate the public about updated environmental issues such as UN Treaty on plastic pollution; a webinar on 12 November with Mr. Sidhant Gupta, the founder of Clearbot and Prof. Christelle Not, the Assistant Professor from the University of Hong Kong and our school iGEM team as guest speakers. There were 250 students participate in the webinar. The team also hosted sharing sessions in Sing Yin Secondary School on 26 November, in our school assembly on 23 March and in International College Hong Kong on 10 May. Besides, ZPL students organized a course "Data Science Experience Course" to teach students how to annotate plastics from photos collected in a dataset of plastics from an open-source tool using CVAT platform. Two workshops were held on 7 February and 26 April and 3,000 images were annotated by student volunteers. ZPL was invited by the Environmental Protection Department to join the "Bye Bye Microbeads" scheme and promote online challenge for students. There were 117 students

participated in the event. With active participation from our students to participate in the online challenge, our outreach activities including the promotion of microplastic pollution and “Bye Bye Microbeads Charter” scheme in the sharing sessions, beach cleanup activities and successful promotion of “Bye Bye Microbeads Charter” scheme online challenge prompt us to receive “Platinum Class” Award and “Excellence Award” from EPD.

Two teams of eight G9 to G10 students participated in the “Clean Air Challenge Competition” organized by HKUST. Out of the 300 participating teams, both teams enter the final round with one receiving the “Best Hardware Presentation” prize. Our school Principal, Assistant Principal and team students were interviewed by HKUST to share their insights in the project.

A team of 10 students participated in the Aerosim Inter-School Aviation Tournament 2022 and gave outstanding performances. In the competition, students engaged in STEM-based presentation, aviation written tests and flight tests. They also experienced a flight simulation in the learning journey. After multiple rounds of competition, a student was awarded “1st Runner up of Future Aviation Leader”, two students were awarded “2nd Runner up of Top 3 Highest Individual Score”, A team of 5 students were awarded 1st Runner up of Best Overall Performance and another team of 5 students were awarded “1st Runner up of Best Presentation”. In November, the Greater Bay Area Science Project Competition (GBASPC) 2022 was successfully held in our school. The event was performed in a hybrid mode. The STEM Forum brought together three professors, Prof. to Ngai, Prof. Hong Ming Lam and Prof. Siu Ming Yiu from universities to share their insights about STEM in coding, agriculture and the future of plastics.

In December, 12 students in 3 teams participated in the Inter-school Formula Edge Competition 2022. One team entered the top 16 finalists.

To enrich STEM education in the campus, our school joined the “Matching Scheme of Chinese Sciences Academicians to Hong Kong Schools” organized by the Hong Kong STEM Education Alliance. Prof. Henry Nai Ching Wong was our school’s science project consultant and Prof. Wong gave a talk “The Art and Science of Organic Synthesis” in December to share with students about the pioneering chemistry topic. Also, 7 science students participated in the Innotech Expo Student Presenter Scheme 2022 to act as the presenters to introduce the most updated achievements of Chinese sciences and technologies to the public at HKCEC, Wanchai.

In January 2023, 3 students attended the 6th Kamnoetvidya Science Academy Invitational Science Fair (KVIS-ISF) organized by KVIS, Thailand. They present their scientific research to hundreds of students from 11 schools around the globe. The students also participate in different cross-cultural exchanges in the activity.

In February 2023, three G11 students joined the Thailand International Science Fair (TISF) to present their research and met with peers from different countries. Besides, our school invited Prof. Lo Yuk Lam, President of Hong Kong Bio-Med Innotech Association to deliver a talk to share how the National Policy and the HKSAR Government Policy provide opportunities for the development of bio-economy.

Three G11 gifted students participated in the Off-school Advanced Learning Programs for Gifted Students-Quantum Computing for Gifted Students (Phase 1) which was held by the Gifted Education Fund, HKUST and the HKAGE from July 2022 to October 2022. Students spent 12 weekends learning quantum computing at HKUST, followed by a project presentation. There were collaborations between school, tertiary institutions, and industries to provide teachers with professional support and resources in technology including a collaborated QEF project entitled “Interdisciplinary STEM Project-based learning in synthetic biology” which was in collaboration with The University of Hong Kong to enhance STEM education by developing a school-based STEM programme in the field of synthetic biology integrated with new technological advances for interdisciplinary project-based learning.

Reflection

With the loosening of Covid preventive measure, students were able to participate in a variety of STEM competition to strengthen their knowledge and skills in the emerging technology including synthetic biology, A.I., robotics, aviation etc. The performance of students was remarkable. A student-led environmental group “Zero Plastic League” was launched to provide opportunities for students to take a leadership role in organizing environmental protection campaign, research and engage their peers in the issue. With active participation from school students, the team will engage different stakeholders to work for the environmental protection activities and research. Collaboration with universities in the GBASPC and QEF project in synthetic biology will be continued to promote the sustainable development of STEAM education in Hong Kong and in the GBA.

Staff Development Days were held and be aimed at updating all teachers about the school directions and achievements to create opportunities for teachers to come together for professional exchanges which have enabled peers to grow their expertise and build harmony, trust and supportive relationships among teachers.

On 25th August, our school invited Prof. Cheng Kai Ming as a guest speaker to share topics including the new generation, new approaches to education, new teachers, the orientation of jobs and how teacher can support education in the future.

On 9 December, there were 4 talks at MISNET MI Forum. The life story of Howard Gardner were shared.

On 20 July, a key staff staycation was held to foster the friendship among teachers.

In addition, a series of five new teacher training sessions (13 Jan, 10 Feb, 10 Mar, 28 April and 19 May) and 1.5 hours per session was held for new teaching staff members at our school. The aims of the training sessions were to introduce school culture and history and share teaching and learning for the MI students.

Workshops, seminar and conferences

Teachers are encouraged to attend the workshops, seminars and conferences organized by the EDB, universities and education institutions for professional development throughout the year.

Teacher Training Program and mentors for new teachers

The Teacher training program is designated for newly recruited teachers from March to August. The program runs from January to May. It emphasizes the skills to teach gifted students which requires professional expertise and resources provided by the school. The school provided appropriate support for new teachers such as the mentor program. Each newly recruited teacher will also be assigned with a mentor and a subject coach who offer help to new teachers to navigate and find their way through the school culture, facilitate their teaching, and support their needs. The mentor allows the new teachers to observe lessons taught by colleagues with

excellent performance in teaching, thereby expediting their adaption to the new environment and work.

(4) Support for Student Development

Gifted and Talented Programs

Our school offers four enrichment programs to nurture the gifted.

1. Clubs and Interest Group (C & I)

C & I group aims to develop students' potential in non-academic areas and there are 29 courses in the group.

2. Talent Class Program

The Talent Class program aims to develop artistic ability of students which is an important capability for the development of creativity, open-mindedness, flexibility, and aesthetic sensitivity. There are 26 courses in the group.

3. Elective Day

The program aims to enrich students' academic knowledge and provide hands-on experience to their subjects of interest. There are 29 courses in the group.

4. Sports Friday

The program aims to arouse students' interest in sports and to develop their athletic ability. There are 32 courses in the group.

Moral education

A holistic approach of life planning education was adopted to support the whole-person development of students. There were morning assemblies every Monday and every Tuesday for teachers, students, and other organizations to share their personal experience, life values and attitude. In order to help students develop a sense of belonging to the school, build leadership skills and get along well with their schoolmates, one lesson is allocated for mentorship and two lessons are allocated to adolescent growth for G7 to provide necessary support to students. For G8, 2 lessons per week are allocated for the leadership training program in which external service is provided to deliver leadership training to students. Teachers and other speakers are also invited to deliver talks and briefing during the allocated time.

Various leadership training programs and community services were established to let students develop their strengths, leadership, and problem-solving skills; community services to elderly centres let students learn to care and love for others and make a contribution to the community. Our school has built a positive and harmonious school environment by having a strong culture of parent-school engagement. The Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) was very supportive to our school. A number of school-wide activities were jointly organized by the Moral Education Group and the PTA this year and there was a high number of parents and teachers participating in the events.

School social worker

Our school works closely with the Hong Kong YWCA to support student development. The organization appoints a social worker to our school, who provides counselling to students in need, communicates and gives advice to students, parents and teachers, she also organizes and coordinates the orientation camp, breakthrough camp and the leadership training programs.

Strong culture of parent-school engagement

The Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) was very supportive to our school. A number of school-wide activities were jointly organized by the Moral Education Group and the PTA this year and there were a high number of parents and teachers participating in the events. Besides the PTA meetings, there were Parents' Night for the effective communication of parents, class teachers, and schools at the beginning of the academic year which was important for the holistic development of students.

Channels of communication with parents

Our school has multiple channels to communicate with parents including the e-notice, *G.T. Blog*, *G.T. Newsletter*, class representative communication, telephone conversation, e-mails, and the WhatsApp group.

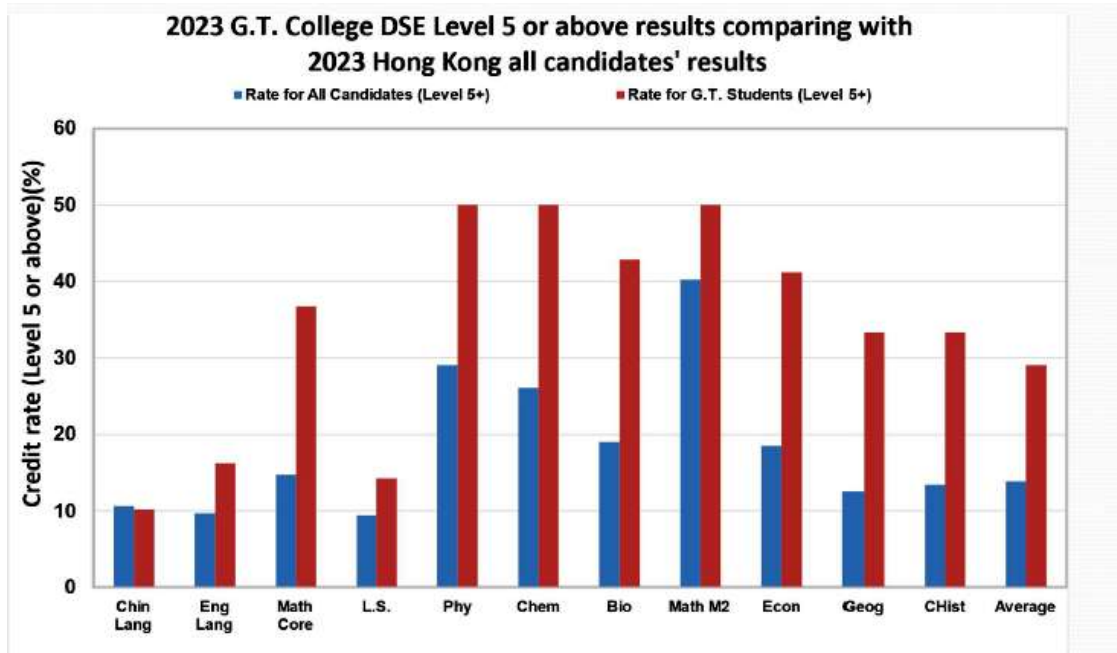
Financial Assistance

The school provides a financial assistance scheme for needy students. This year, 7.1% students were eligible for the assistance.

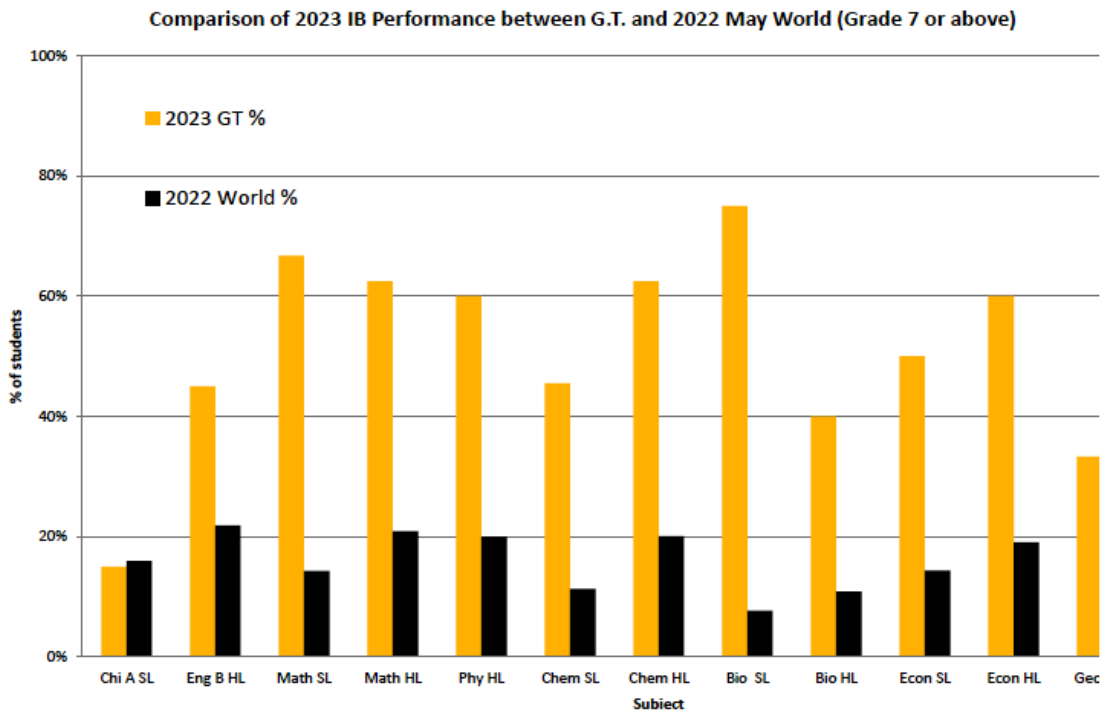

(7) Feedback on Future Planning

- This year, our school has opened and provided diverse learning experience for students in different areas both nationally and internationally. These competitions allow students to interface with global challenges, new sports and Olympiad events and earn awards to recognise their efforts. Besides, more project-based competitions in which the learning processes developed students' generic skills such as communication, team works, collaboration, etc in addition to knowledge and skills were provided for students to participated. Furthermore, more international exchange programmes were resumed physically due to the loosening of COVID preventive measure. Continuous supports will be provided for students to explore and unleash their potential in different areas.
- Our school students joined the Greater Bay Area Youth Exchange Program in Guangzhou to visit universities and firms to learn the latest technological developments of the area, exchange with students in Guangzhou and went to cultural heritage sites. More visits to different cities of Greater Bay Area (GBA) will be arranged to build up connection between students in different GBA and to allow students to learn of recent development of the GBA.
- The school will continue to engage parents and alumni in school activities and stay connected with global networks for knowledge and cultural exchange.
- Different Government policy makers were invited to share the blueprint for youth development and recent country development in order to nurture students with an affection for our country and Hong Kong and equipped with global perspective, an aspiring mind-set and positive thinking. Students also had chance to participate community service in order to develop a good citizenship. More related activities will be explored to let students to build sense of belonging to the country and Hong Kong. Community services will be continued to develop students to be a well-informed and responsible citizen.
- With the loosening of Covid preventive measure, students were able to participate in a variety of STEM competition to strengthen their knowledge and skills in the emerging technology including synthetic biology, A.I., robotics, aviation etc. A student-led environmental group was launched to provide opportunities for students to take a leadership role in organizing environmental protection campaign, research and engage their peers in the issue. Collaboration with universities in the GBASPC and QEF project in synthetic biology will be continued to promote the sustainable development of STEAM education in Hong Kong and in the GBA.
