Vision

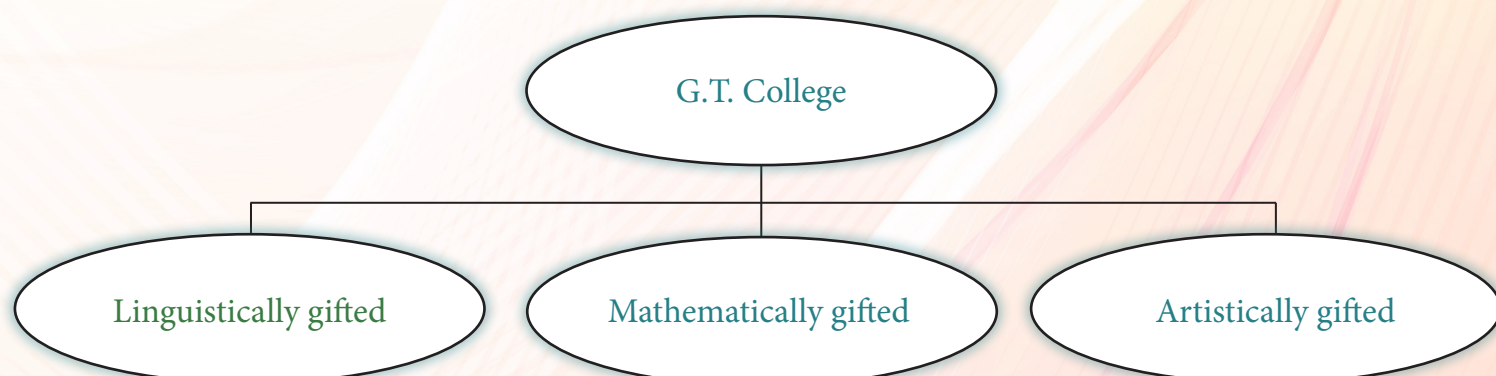
The vision of G.T. College is to nurture future leaders with:

5 THE EMI MODE OF LEARNING

G.T. College is a school using English as the medium of instruction (EMI). In order to implement the EMI policy successfully, the college uses EMI with our Grade 5 students, so that they can proceed to EMI secondary education smoothly:

Grade 6	Bilingual teaching in Maths and Science
Grade 7 (Secondary 1)	Classes are taught in English with support given to individuals
Grade 8 (Secondary 2)	All classes are taught in English

6 CURRICULUM GUIDELINES AND SYLLABUSES

G.T. College follows and further develops the EDB curriculum guidelines and syllabuses. The school syllabuses covers extensions in various subject domains. Teaching and learning proceeds at a quicker pace and students' active participation will be emphasized. Students sit for Hong Kong DSE Exams as well as international public exams, such as IGCSE and Cambridge ESOL.

While the HKDSE is the mainstream of the senior curriculum for our students, G.T. College has been authorized by the International Baccalaureate Organization to offer the IB Diploma Programme (IBDP) since 2018.

In the academic year 2022-2023, through the Joint University Admission Scheme, over 50% of students were accepted into the top three universities in Hong Kong (HKU, CUHK, and HKUST). Among them, six students were admitted to the medical school. Additionally, in terms of overseas education, students also achieved outstanding results by being admitted to prestigious universities globally, including the University of Cambridge in the UK and Cornell University in the USA.

7 SCHOOL FEATURES

1. Outstanding English Proficiency

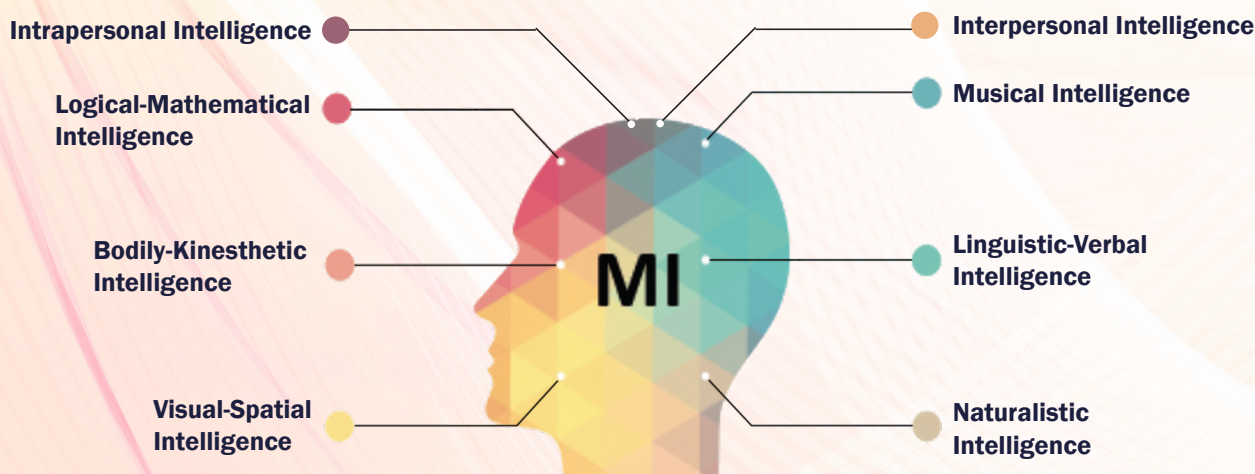
G.T. College hires Native English Teachers (NET) to facilitate upgrading students' English proficiency. Over the years, G.T. students have been performing extraordinary well in local and international assessments of English. An incomparably high 86.4% of our students achieved Band 6.5 or above in the IELTS(2022), with 39% of them achieving Band 7.5, and more than 25% of the cohort attaining Band 8 or above in the year.

2. Small Class Size

G.T. College has been a pioneer and advocate of Small Class Teaching(SCT) in Hong Kong since 1996. With small class ranging from 22-28 students per class, teachers are able to have more contact with students. Carefully chosen teaching materials are customized to cater for individual needs.

3. Multiple Intelligences (MI)

G.T. College embraces the idea of Multiple Intelligences. Everybody has his/her individual potential and talent which can be realized through education. There are gifted and talented programs offering 125 programs for students to choose from.



4. International Exchange Program

Through different exchange programs with overseas schools and institutes, G.T. students are in touch with different cultures and students from foreign countries. The college has established networks with internationally-renowned schools for the formulation of their programs for gifted students.

5. G.T. Pyramid and Life Education

The G.T. Pyramid is our direction where academic performance is at the basic level of our vision, with a step-by-step ascension to talent development, moral education, leadership and then life education. Life Education is defined as an education for living a good, positive and meaningful life and for making the best out of one's life : where good and meaningful living invariably include goal-setting, critical thinking, creativity, and action.



6. Teaching Chinese Language in Putonghua

Putonghua is the medium of instruction in junior Chinese Language classes (G7-G8). Visits and exchange programs with schools in China will also enhance students' Putonghua Proficiency.

7. Leadership Training

G.T. College offers leadership training sessions to G8. They are then assigned leadership positions for organizing community services and programs. G9–G11 students may join the school prefect team and organize whole-school and inter-school events. All students participate in class associations, clubs and the student union.

8 CURRICULUM FEATURES

Apart from the regular class periods, the following gifted programs are implemented in G.T. College:

1. Accelerated and Enrichment Class

(a) There are six groups of Accelerated and Enrichment Class:

(i) Chinese (ii) English (iii) Mathematics (iv) Science (v) Music (vi) Sports

Each child with talents in the above domains will be selected to join one of the groups.

(b) Each group will cover advanced topics beyond the school's general syllabuses.

2. Talent Class

G7–G10 students will choose one among 26 classes, which are tailored to students' preferences. Students would attend the class once a week.

3. Elective Day

(a) 26 courses are offered during each term and a student may select one course to attend. A short term paper or project will be required for each course.

4. Mentorship Program and Adolescent Growth

An integrated School-based Curriculum with lectures, games and activities:

5. 3rd Language Classes

Five Western European and Asian languages are available for our students, including German, French, Spanish, Japanese, and Korean. Students attend the classes twice a week to cultivate their interests in world cultures.

願景

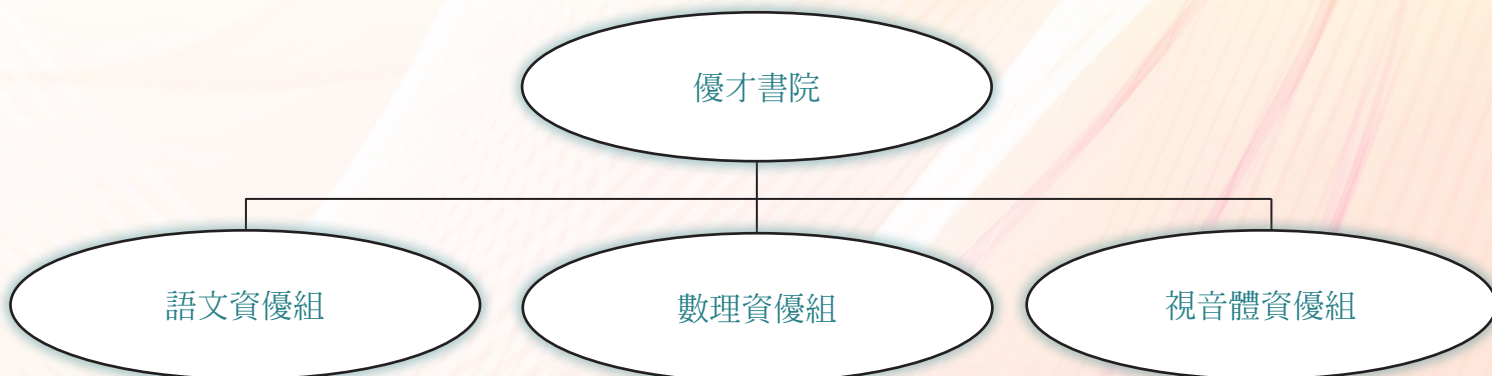
培育未來領袖，他們需具備下列條件：

五 英語授課

優才書院以英語授課。爲了讓學生更快地適應這種教學模式，本校自五年級起全面滲透英語教學，令學生逐步適應。我們採取下列措施：

六年級	舉辦升中銜接課程，教授升中英語、數學及綜合科學科，其中數學及科學科以中英雙語授課。
七年級（中一）	全英語授課，首學段輔以粵語，並爲個別學生提供輔導。
八年級（中二）	全英語授課

六 課程指引及大綱

優才書院根據教育局的課程指引及大綱，自行釐定更深入和全面的課程。教學進度較快、內容將較深較廣，並強調學生自主學習。學生除應考文憑試外，也會參與國際性的公開考試，如國際普通中學教育文憑試和劍橋英語考試。

優才書院的高中課程一向以香港中學文憑課程 (HKDSE) 爲主，於 2018 年，優才書院得到國際文憑課程授權，開辦國際預科文憑課程 (IBDP)。

二零二二年至二零二三年度，經大學聯合招生辦法獲本地大學取錄，當中超過 50% 學生入讀本港排名前三的香港大學、香港中文大學及香港科技大學，其中 6 名同學獲醫學院取錄。此外，在海外升學方面，同學亦創下佳績，升讀歐美頂尖大學，包括英國劍橋大學及美國康乃爾大學。

七 學校特色

1. 英語優勢，等同國際

優才書院聘用外籍老師教授英語，藉此提昇同學英語溝通技巧。多年來，學生於本地及國際的英文考試上都有出色表現。2022 年，86.4% 學生在雅思國際英語測驗系統 (IELTS) 評估中取得 Band 6.5 或以上，其中 39% 的學生取得 Band 7.5，超過 25% 的學生取得 Band 8 或以上，成績斐然。

2. 國際特色，小班教學

本校推行小班教學，每班約 22-28 個學生。有助老師掌握每位學生的學習進程，增加師生互動，以作出個別回饋及指導。

3. 多元智能，才華超卓

每人都有不同於他人的智能結構，造就個人的智慧與潛能。優才書院開辦 125 個不同的資優才華班讓學生選修，致力開發及培養學生的多元智能。

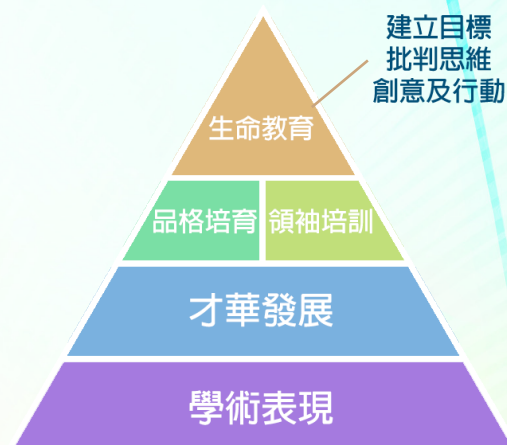


4. 國際交流

優才書院與多所國際知名的院校共建網絡，為資優學生籌辦不同學習活動。學生藉著參加各種與海外院校交流的學習活動，不但博識外地文化，結交更多各國朋友，與國際學者建立緊密聯繫。

5. 優才生命教育理念

優才的教育理念是建基於相信教育是長遠的。教育金字塔中，學術成績是基本的，第二層是發展人的天賦才華，第三層是培養人的品格和領袖才能。最終，我們的目標是重視生命教育，讓學生擁有正面思維，確立目標與批判思考，具創意並勇於嘗試，建立有意義的人生。



6. 以普通話教授中國語文

普通話作為初中中文科的授課語言（七至八年級）。另外，為增強學生的普通話能力，學校不時會帶學生到中國內地參觀和交流。

7. 領袖培訓

優才為八年級提供一系列領袖培訓活動，學生能建立組織學會和活動的能力。九年級至十一年級學生可參與領袖生團隊，組織全校的活動。全校學生均有機會參與班會、學會和學生會各組織活動。

八 課程特色

除了一般正常課堂外，本校更會推行多項資優課程：

1. 加速及增潤班

- (a) 加速及增潤班分為六組，按學生的才華，編排入不同的組別：
- (i) 中文 (ii) 英文 (iii) 數學 (iv) 科學 (v) 音樂 (vi) 體育
- (b) 教授課外的進階課程。

2. 才華班

七至十年級學生按個人才華及意願從 26 個課程中選讀一個，每星期上課一次。

3. 選修日

- (a) 每學期將有 26 個課程供學生學選修，每人需選修一個課程，並完成相關習作。
- (b) 課程內容，可參考本校網頁。

4. 導師啟航課程及成長課

成長課為校本課程，形式包括遊戲和其他課堂活動等。內容涵蓋：

- (a) 青少年成長 (b) 自我與身分認同 (c) 情緒管理
- (d) 人際關係 (e) 品格教育 (f) 性教育
- (g) 義工服務

5. 第三語言課程

現時優才學生可選擇修讀五種西歐或亞洲語言，包括德語、法語、西班牙語、日語和韓語；通過每周約兩小時的課程以培養他們對世界文化的興趣。
